








#### X BOARD EXAM RESULTS


#### INTRODUCTION OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE SUBJECT IN CLASS IX

## **INAUGURATION OF FIVE STAR BLOCK & OUTDOOR AUDITORIUM**


